Use the context of Academic Motivation, Interests and Community Involvement

(2 Paragraphs Max / 300 Max Words)

Question: Please tell us about your plans for your education and community involvement. We want to learn about your academic career and extracurricular activities you are involved in. Purpose: to understand you and your interests both academically and in the community.

Use the context of Personal Growth, Resilience, and Career Aspirations

(2-3 Paragraphs / 200-500 Words)

Question: Please tell us about your career goals and explain how you plan to accomplish them. This can be what you are currently doing or what your long-term aspirations are. Purpose: to understand what you want to do and challenge you to think of how.

Use the context of Personal Values & Ethics

(3 Paragraphs / 300-500 Words)

Question: What values or principles guide your decisions and actions?

Provide an example of how these values have influenced a specific decision or action in your life. Purpose: To assess the applicant's personal values, ethical considerations, and how these principles are applied in real-life situations.

Supply Chain Question

(One Page / 500-1000 Words)

Question: Share a link to an article of your choice relating to issues in our supply chain.

Provide a response on why and how this affects our society's daily lives. Provide brief insight on how you think we can solve this problem.

Purpose: To get the applicant to think about the importance of supply chain and the importance of our industries and how it relates to you in daily civilian life.
